OUR OUTREACH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

The children that grow up in poverty, abused or neglected, are one of the greatest threats to a healthy child's development. Poverty, financial stress, and bad family relationship can impede children's cognitive development, their ability to learn, poor health, behavioral, social and emotional problems. Providing clean diapers to a newborn baby, food for a hungry child, safety for an abused, neglected and abandoned child and foster home to children in crisis. These kids need our protective and healing love!

We provide the following to kids in need at NO cost to them and their families.



CHILD COMFORT BAG

Each bag includes hygiene products - grooming kit, toiletries, first aid kit, clothing accessories, non-perishable snacks, age appropriate toy, book, and writing material.



SCHOOL READY BAG

Each bag includes age appropriate school supplies, non-perishable snack and reusable water bottle.



BABY WELCOME BAG

Diaper bag, hygiene kit - grooming, first aid & toiletries, diapers, wipes, towel, clothes/accessories, feeding supplies, blankets (receiving, wearable) resources of child development & parenting information (websites, blogs, books, etc.).



BIRTHDAY IN A BOX

Age appropriate party birthday theme decoration, cake, candles, and small gift.



Life has its ups and downs; people may fall into a position in their life unexpectedly and then go downward spiral. Poverty in America is more about a lack of basic necessities and a lack of security. Even though we don't have starvation in America, we do have an amount of poverty that leads to malnutrition and diseases that we don't tend to associate with First World countries. 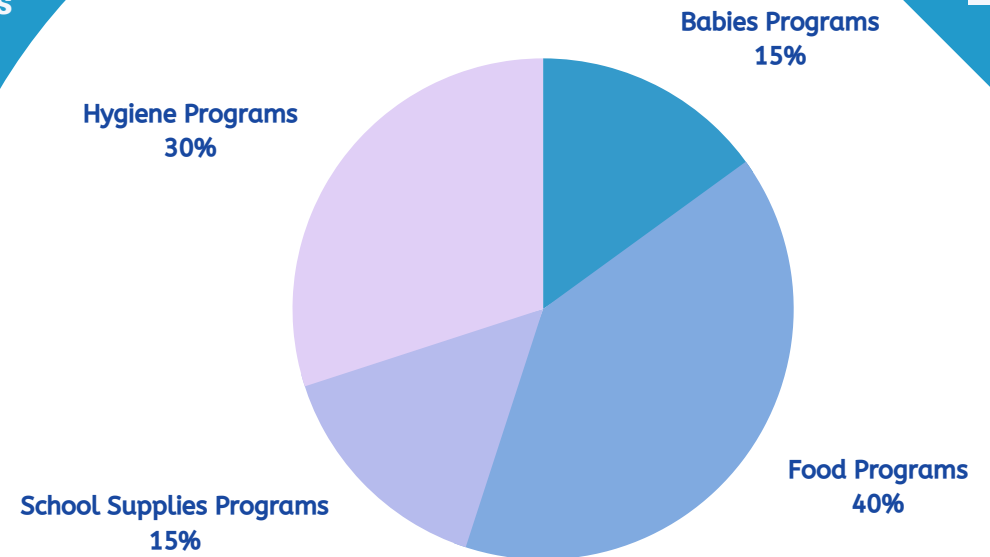

On an annual basis we at Mother and Child Charity perform a needs assessment in order to determine the actual measurable need to the problem our nonprofit wishes to solve. The process we approach are describing the need, quantifying the need, identifying who addresses the need, and identifying who we serve. We collect and analyze data from our surveys, interviews, review the data that has already been collected by census, DCF annual performance reports and other available public reports. A mix of both primary and secondary data is ideal to support our vision. Completing this process is particularly important for us since we are often tackling very specific challenges of society's largest problems. Determining the context of our perceived need is the first step in the assessment process. We analyze questions about the community, the problems and the number of people in need. Our observation includes the broad problems and the specific problems. Both aspects are important, but zeroing in on the details of what we can solve will give context to our purpose, mission, and programs. Once we have identified exactly who our charity recipients are, we proceed with our strategic planning and successfully execute projects. Our charity recipients come from all walks of life, they have unique and different stories behind them. We do not violate their rights of publicizing their identity as we respect their privacy and protecting their identity is very important to us. Any pictures or videos we do publicize are with permission only.



Exploring the core of the need guides us in finding concrete data and provide us with a solid framework for our project scope. Our main focus continues to be the youth, who are our future! One of the negative implications of education and childhood poverty is that they fall behind in school due to fewer resources available at home to complete homework, study, or engage in activities that helps equip them for success during the school day. In addition to having limited access to food and housing security which often have a greater risk of school drop-out for today's youths. For a positive result we have in place various programs to address this problem. For example providing the youths and families in poverty with food, care bags and school ready bags helps relieve the families from financial stress. This will also allow parents succeed at work and promotes children's health and wellbeing.
